<u>Matters Arising from Previous Minutes</u>: Response sent to Lars de Kruijf re complaint re testing course depth. Lars has since advised that his staff member has resigned.

Financial Statement: presented and accepted. Approx. combined net position \$177,640.

Accounts for Payment: Accounts previously paid and to be paid were circulated and approved.

<u>Resigning Council Members</u>: Warren Carlsen, Kevin Warner & Travis Mcintosh have advised that they will be standing down from MPTA Council effective today.

<u>TTC Report</u>: March & April ISO machine testing courses have been cancelled due to Covid-19. Accountants are investigating if there is any advantage in continuing TTC as a separate entity to MPTA or if it can be dissolved and MPTA manages the training courses & income. They are checking with IRD if MPTA is exempt from Income Tax, not just Withholding Tax which we have an exemption certificate for – generally the two exemptions go hand in hand.

<u>Plumbers Act Review</u>: G Reilly & M Scott met with Minister Damien O'Connor on 02/03/20. The Minister requested that we seek clarification from the PGDB around water schemes and who is authorised to undertake works on these schemes, including installation, servicing & repair.

<u>Water Services Regulator Bill:</u> We made a submission on this Bill on 4/3/20 which also stated our desire to be part of the Rural Drinking Water Advisory Group that is to be established – haven't had any response as yet.

<u>Electrical Supervision</u>: Kevin White has suggested that, due to the lack of response from Skills Org or EWRB, we present EWRB with a test case of someone who has completed the EST training & exam but not been ale to achieve the supervision requirement. E.O. to source as suitable candidate.

<u>Skilled Water Tradespeople</u>: An application and assessment material has been developed and two people have been approached to prepare trial applications which we will then have assessed by Hugh Gallagher. After this trial has been completed we will be better able to set the cost for applications. It was planned to launch the new Certification pathway at the AGM on 26/3/20, however, due to Covid-19 it will now be launched at a later date.

<u>ISO Testing conversion</u>: First trail course scheduled for week 20/03/20 has been postponed due to Covid-19. Trial and launch of ISO testing has been postponed to later in the year.

Next meeting date: Expected to be mid-May 2020 in Hamilton.
