

## Presidents Report for the Year Ending 31 December 2025

As MPTA President, I have the pleasure of reporting the year's activities and tasks undertaken on your behalf by your elected Committee.

Welcome to our Life Members and to our members – thank you for your ongoing support and input.

This AGM marks our 94th year, we have been established since 1932.

Our financial position remains strong even though we made a net loss of \$25,066.00 for the year. This loss factors in Amortisation of \$31,778 mainly aligned to development investment of over \$100,000 over the past 3½ years for four new NZQA Micro-Credentials qualifications.

The majority of MPTA equity is made up of non-tangible assets, such as course development and software programs. These assets contribute to our Member Equity figure and assist in tax calculations at year end.

Member equity has decreased from \$344,544 to \$316,374.00

Equity is Non-Tangible to a large degree and is made up of course development and Micro-Credential costs etc. This is not a cash value, so not easily converted to cash.

The net bank balance as at 31/12/25 was \$12,154.00

The current bank balance is \$80,681.92 as 2026 Member subscriptions and income from a couple of courses already run have come in.

In 2025 we trained 151 participants bringing in income of \$224K. The majority of training income came in from 4 ISO Machine Testing courses with 37 participants which brought in \$114,495. The revised Small Drinking Water Supplies course was a standout in 2024 with 72 learners going through this training, bringing in income of \$60,105

MPTA closed the 2025 year with 221 current ISO Milking Machine Testers, a noticeable increase in numbers from previous years. Plus there are an additional 32 Testers holding provisional testing licenses before they become fully licensed.

Membership numbers are 196 – this has remained stable over the past couple of years.

Thank you to our existing MPTA Council Members for the support and time that you volunteer at your own cost, and to the OEMs and Members who have contributed & helped over the past year.

I would like to take the opportunity to thank the Council Committee Members, past and present. for their efforts over the past year and over the years that I have been involved on the MPTA Council. Thank you also to our Executive Officer, Maria, who delivers a massive contribution to the day to day running of the Association.

This is the last report that I will write as your MPTA President. I want to thank the many people that have helped, contributed and been instrumental in the progress of MPTA during my time, none more than Craig Burrows and Maria Scott. The behind the scenes hours and meetings has been a massive effort over the years with some huge achievements, so thanks to you both, I can leave this role knowing that we have made the MPTA a better place.

Thank you also to our Members for your ongoing support, on behalf of the Council, we wish you a successful 2026.
