

STRAY VOLTAGE TESTING

DATES:

This course is offered on request and is completed online which means that this course can be completed at any time by simply using a computer either at home or in the workplace. It will take approx. 7 hours to complete all the course material and online assessments.

COURSE DISCRIPTION

This online, self-paced course is designed to give participants an understanding of what causes stray voltage problems in and around the farm dairy and includes how to evaluate voltage gradients and make recommendations.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Anyone involved in advising farmers on good milking practice and function such as milking machine dealer staff, sales reps, OEMs, local agents – fitters and testers, vets and advisors.

COURSE CONTENT

Participants will learn:

- basic theory relating to power reticulation
- an understanding of why stray voltage problems occur
- how to recognise signs of stray voltage
- how to use a volt meter
- diagnosis and recommendations

A Certificate of Achievement will be issued to participants who successfully complete the course.



Participants are able to order the same design volt meter testing equipment used on the course demonstrations. This will enable them to put what they have learnt into practice.
